Tasmania's first Coastal Rowing Regatta

Rowing Tasmania has sanctioned the 2024 Wrest Point Sandy Bay Regatta as the first Offshore Rowing Regatta in the state.

There are three classes of boat and three formats.

Coastal Doubles:

Three double sculls are kindly being supplied by Glenorchy Rowing Club. The racing for these will be a traditional sprint from the Pontoon to Long Point, approx. 350m.

Coastal Singles (yellow boats):

Teams of three. Triangular course around Long Beach, with Le Mans start and finish for each member. Rowing Tasmania have kindly supplied six recreational sculls for the event.

Coxed Coastal Quads:

Lindisfarne Rowing Club will be providing two coxed offshore quad sculls. They will be racing around the John Garrow light, one or two races per division depending on numbers.

Divisions:

Masters from any club are invited to come along and try racing in the new format.

It's envisaged that there will be juniors from Sandy Bay and New Norfolk. First races in club colours, second batch of races mix and match.

Mixed masters and juniors

The final division is mixed masters and juniors.
